TRAINING

Some preschoolers may have difficulty speaking or speaking (such as stuttering). It is not always easy to know how to detect these issues and how to intervene. Applying different stimulation strategies is of great benefit to any child with a communication problem. The earlier you intervene in your life, the better your chances of success.

Our trainings are divided into two separate course. Each one consists of a 3 hour training session.

Training 1: Do your best talking, I'll do my best listening

Training 2: Deepening the knowledge

You must do the course 1 before the course 2.
