

AKA – 027 MEMBER SELF-REPORTING FORM

Disclosure: it is the professional obligation of every practicing and non-practicing member to self-report any breaches in their own conduct. Once the breach occurs, self-reporting is required as soon as reasonably possible and mandatory on each annual renewal. Types of conduct to self-report include:

- charge of a criminal offence under the Criminal Code (Canada),
- conviction of a criminal offence under the Criminal Code (Canada),
- finding of professional negligence,
- decisions of unprofessional conduct by an organization in another jurisdiction, and/or,
- decisions of unprofessional conduct by another Association or College in Alberta or another jurisdiction.

Self-report is required by both the Health Professions Act and the Code of Ethics of the Alberta Kinesiology Association (AKA-009). By self-reporting, members understand they may be subject to investigation, suspension, and/or other disciplinary measures.
