NATIONAL ANIMAL STERILIZATION WEEK IN QUEBEC

Aware of the need to show Ouebecers that veterinarians are concerned about the number of abandoned animals, the Association des médecins vétérinaires du Québec en pratique des petits animaux (AMVQ) is pleased not only to have initiated a national animal sterilization day in Ouebec but also to have drawn attention to the strong involvement of its members. In fact, 96% of the members support this day!







Every year, an average of 225 veterinary hospitals and the majority of veterinarians working in animal shelters participate in various ways in the national animal sterilization day.

Among the actions taken, let us mention the promotion of the Website www. sterilisationanimalequebec.info and the sterilization of the cats from the SPA/SPCA, the municipal animal services or organisms who capture stray cats.

Other activities are also organized during that special day: gifts offered to those who have their animal sterilized, prize draws, school visits, letters sent to municipal politicians, donations to organisms that help animals, etc. Many projects are also organized, such as promotions on the Web, Facebook and Twitter, open houses, news releases in local newspapers, etc.

In 2016, the AMVQ has decided to change the concept. The one day event became the National Animal Sterilization WEEK in Quebec. We want to show animal owners that the issue is important enough to promote sterilization during one whole week rather than only one day per year.

Also, every year, the AMVQ organizes a contest for the public and the veterinary community.

Thus, in 2016, it was a photo contest where participant owners provided a portrait with their pet and their veterinarian during a consultation.

Like Royal Canin, the CDMV, the City of Montréal and ANIMA-Québec
