He arrived in Gatineau in September with an confrere (Didier Hadonou). The Marist Fathers' community sent them here to develop a pastoral project. When they met with Bishop Durocher, he asked them to see how they could help welcome young immigrant families.

Mario will first try to meet with the parish priests, to introduce himself, and then to see how to collaborate in developing a delicate attention to those around us who need our attention.
