**Title:** Measuring the SDGs feels out of your co-operative's reach? Not anymore!

**Abstract:** You have heard about the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), but feel you do not have enough information. You have wondered how you can bring the SDG framework to your co-operative. Measuring the SDGs has felt out of your co-operative's reach? Not anymore! There is a great opportunity for co-operatives to learn more about the SDGs, to move beyond commentary and reflection on sustainability in general, and to a place of action and implementation based on the SDG targets. In this interactive presentation you will accomplish three tasks: 1) you will learn more about the SDG framework and how it connects to co-operatives; 2) you will have a chance to measure and report on key indicators within the SDG framework; and 3) you will gain insight into how you can stretch measuring and reporting on your co-operatives' activities to the SDGs.
