Overview

This year's ISD provides an excellent opportunity to hear from ESA and other key stakeholders in the European space industry, showcase products and services and meet future partners. As in previous years, the Agency expects more than 1500 participants on-site at ESTEC.

Key elements of the event include:

- pre-scheduled **1-on-1 meetings** to establish new contacts in an efficient and timesaving manner
- an **exhibition** with 170 ESA and industry booths and the possibility to engage with future partners (already fully booked)
- **a conference** with ESA presentations, panels and workshops about business opportunities and market trends

The event is open to entities and investors from ESA Member States, Associate States and Cooperating States.

The registration fee is **EUR 50 (excl. VAT)** and includes entry to the event, access to the B2B platform, shuttle bus services as well as two lunches and a networking reception.

After a successful validation by the Agency, you will receive an email within 5 working days with a link to the registration portal where you are kindly requested to provide additional information and complete the payment.

Afterwards you will be provided with access to the meeting platform. At this point in time, you can complete your company profile page. Before the summer, you will be able to access the catalogue of participants to plan your 1-on-1 meetings.
